City of Medicine Lake Special Meeting to Canvass Election Results

Resolution No. 20-13 declaring the results of the general municipal election of 2020 was read by Mayor Marks, Election results were presented to council by Election Clerk Joshua Hauble. Josh Hauble attested that he believed that the results of the election and the information contained in the Abstract of Votes Cast was true and accurate and the election was conducted without evidence of fraud. Scott Marks was declared Mayor elect to a two-year term commencing on January 5, 2021. Chris Heim and Joyce Meyer were declared council member elects each to a four-year term commencing January 5, 2021. Connie Shaffer was declared council member elect each to a two-year term commencing January 5, 2021 and expiring on January 2, 2023.
