

Meeting Minutes Planning Commission

City of Medicine Lake Meeting was held virtual via Zoom May 19, 2022 6:00 pm

Topic: Medicine Lake Planning Commission

Time: May 19, 2022 06:00 PM Central Time

Location: Meeting held virtual via zoom as follows:

1. Call to order and roll call
 - a) The meeting was called to order at 6:01 pm.
 - b) Members present include – Jesse Swanson, Glen Skajewski, Bill Enright, Brad Beisel, and Shaun Kennedy. Debbi Stafne and Laura Ferenci were not present.
2. Approval of Agenda
 - a) Brad moves to approve agenda, Glen second and all voted in favor.
3. Approval of Minutes from February 17th 2022 and March 17th 2022 Minutes
 - a) Bill moves to Glen second all voted in favor (Brad abstained).
4. Public Hearings: None scheduled
5. New Business: None
6. Old Business:
 - a) Commissioner Kennedy reviewed survey results. These included an electronic copy and paper copies which were tabulated by Commissioner Kennedy. Commissioner Kennedy went through a series of slides providing an overview of the survey. Discussion ensued regarding the findings and next steps.
 - Need to clarify difference between rental vs a house sitter (friends and family who are their while you are gone on vacation)

- Direction is to present findings to the City Council and then take further direction from the City Council.

- b) Draft Shoreland Ordinance and Wetland Ordinance updates. Scheib reviewed edits to the shoreland ordinance based on prior commissioner discussions including reinserting provisions from the current ordinance that restricts certain grading practices within 20 feet of the OHW. Scheib also walked through the wetland ordinance draft as a requirement based on BCWMC system plan and state rules. Commissioner Kennedy discussed the BCWMC desire to seek public input on the community's willingness to participate in various shoreland and water quality improvements. Glenn discussed a prior program funded through the City of Plymouth for similar actions. It's a similar project through shore restoration services. Jesse indicated he would discuss with the City of Plymouth the shore restoration program. A public hearing will be schedule for June 23rd.
7. Adjournment – Glenn – moved adjournment at 7:16. Brad second and all voted in favor.
